



Happy Summer! The temperature is rising and things are beginning to open back up! We are still only open for Curb-side services for at least a couple more weeks. We are thinking that by July 1st we should be about ready to allow people back into the store. We have been being extra cautious with our store so that we can ensure that we will stay open and not have to face any type of closure due to us getting sick. Please bear with us for a little while longer. We want to get back to normal just as much as everybody else.

When we do open our doors to the public again we will be requesting that people wear masks when they come into the store. We will be wearing our masks as well. We are also asking our customers to leave their pets at home, unless they are coming in for a grooming appointment or nail trim. (We can not take walk-ins at this time). Zephyr and Phinny will be with their grandparents for a while to cut down on the amount of contact/cross contamination that can occur with the doggos wanting all the attention (plus we are required to keep dogs 6 feet apart if they are not a part of the same household to continue grooming).

We have updated our store's hours to allow for more open times. We are now open for curbside services on Monday and Tuesday from 12n-5p as well as Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 12n-6p. We will be staying closed on Wednesdays and Sundays for the foreseeable future. When our store does open back up fully we will probably be moving back

to our regular hours with the exception of Sundays.

During the last 6 weeks the store has had some stocking issues pop up but most of them have been rectified at this point. Purina products are still largely out of stock but most other brands are back to normal.

We are stocking up on our cleaning and disinfecting products to be sure we are ready to allow customers into the store. This has been a long process because everything is out of stock or you are limited at the time of purchase. We have products to keep the grooming area impeccably clean but we have to be sure we are prepared for what is required for the store to open to the public. We hope everyone understands this isn't just about us it is also about your safety.

Our grooming services have seen a huge jump as far as booked appointments are concerned. We are now scheduling about 7-8 weeks out. Please keep this in mind if/when you are wanting to schedule appointments for grooming. We are still able to get nail trims in within a couple of weeks.
